

Burning Permit

Burning Permits are Required for Town Residents

Burning permits are free. Permits are available by contacting Town Board Supervisor Laverne Hoitomt.

Before You Burn, You Must Call To Pre-register Your Fire (715) 386-4701

Remember to call the St. Croix County Communication Center (Non-Emergency) (715) 386-4701 before you burn. This call does not replace calling the town board for a burning permit. By calling to register your burn, your address will be entered into the County's system. In the event that someone calls 911 to report your fire, they can prevent the Fire Department from responding to your address in error.

If you don't call and the Fire Department is sent to your location, you will be responsible for all of the expenses...even if you have a valid permit.

Open burning is not a right! It is a privilege. You are responsible if your fire gets out of control. You will be liable for all expenses incurred in suppressing the fire and will be responsible for all damages caused by the fire.
