Residents are encouraged to take advantage of free drinking water screening clinics offered by St. Croix County.

The third free nitrate screening clinic of 2021 will be offered at the

Kinnickinnic Town Hall (1271 County Rd J, River Falls, WI, 54022) on July 27th from 2-6 pm. Additional nitrate screening clinics will be scheduled throughout the County to take place during the summer of 2021, and details will become available as they are scheduled. This program is offered to educate homeowners on how to monitor and protect their drinking water supply. The event has been modified to address the COVID-19 social distancing guidelines advised by local, state, and federal public health officials. If you plan to attend the event, you must wear a mask and practice social distancing amongst participants and staff by following the signs and taped floors at the event. Participants are asked to bring in about eight ounces of water in a closed container, preferably glass, collected within 24 hours of the clinic event. It is important to run the tap for 10 to 15 minutes on cold at full flow before collecting the sample. A video tutorial can be found on the County website. The nitrate analysis results are provided on-site, and staff will be available to discuss and interpret the results and advise further action as needed.
